What are cookies?

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer or mobile device. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's or mobile device's hard drive.

This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our Site and also allows us to make the Site function properly, make it more secure, understand how the Site performs and improve our Site.

What types of cookies do we use?

We use the following cookies:

COOKIE CATEGORY	Details
Necessary	These are cookies that are required for the operation of our Site. These cookies are essential for you to be able to experience the full functionality of our Site. They allow us to maintain user sessions and prevent any security threats. They do not collect or store any personal information.
Functional	These are the cookies that help certain non-essential functionalities on our Site. These functionalities include embedding content like videos or sharing content of the Site on social media platforms.
Analytics	These are cookies that allow us to recognize and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our Site when they are using them, the source of the visit, etc. This helps us to understand and analyze how well the Site performs and to improve the way our Site works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
Advertisement	Advertisement cookies are used to provide visitors with relevant ads and marketing campaigns. These cookies track visitors across websites and collect information to provide customized ads.

You can find more information about the individual cookie we use and the purposes for which we use it in the table below:

1. Necessary

Necessary cookies are required to enable the basic features of this site, such as providing secure log-in or adjusting your consent preferences. These cookies do not store any personally identifiable data.

Cookie	Duration	Description
PHPSESSID	session	This cookie is native to PHP applications. The cookie stores and identifies a user's unique session ID to manage user sessions on the website. The cookie is a session cookie and will be deleted when all the browser windows are closed.
wt_consent	1 year	Used for remembering users' consent preferences to be respected on subsequent site visits. It does not collect or store personal information about visitors to the site.
apbct_visible_fields	never	CleanTalk sets this cookie to prevent spam on the site's comments/forms, and to act as a complete anti-spam solution and firewall for the site.
ct_pointer_data	never	CleanTalk sets this cookie to prevent spam on the site's comments/forms, and to act as a complete anti-spam solution and firewall for the site.
apbct_headless	never	Cleantalk set this cookie to detect spam and improve the website's security.
apbct_page_hits	never	CleanTalk sets this cookie to prevent spam on comments and forms and act as a complete anti-spam solution and firewall for the site.
elementor	never	The website's WordPress theme uses this cookie. It allows the website owner to implement or change the website's content in real-time.
ct_timezone	never	CleanTalk–Used to prevent spam on our comments and forms and acts as a complete anti-spam solution and firewall for this site.

wpEmojiSettingsSupports	session	WordPress sets this cookie when a user interacts with emojis on a WordPress site. It helps determine if the user's browser can display emojis properly.
ct_has_scrolled	never	CleanTalk sets this cookie to store dynamic variables from the browser.
m	1 year 1 month 4 days	Stripe sets this cookie for fraud prevention purposes. It identifies the device used to access the website, allowing the website to be formatted accordingly.
__stripe_mid	1 year	Stripe sets this cookie to set a unique session identifier to recognize users across sessions.
__stripe_sid	1 hour	Stripe sets this cookie to set a unique session identifier for a single session.

2. Functional

Functional cookies help perform certain functionalities like sharing the content of the website on social media platforms, collecting feedback, and other third-party features.

sbjs_migrations	session	Sourcebuster sets this cookie to identify the source of a visit and stores user action information in cookies. This analytical and behavioural cookie is used to enhance the visitor experience on the website.

ct_screen_info	never	CleanTalk sets this cookie to complete an anti-spam solution and firewall for the website, preventing spam from appearing in comments and forms.

4. Performance

Performance cookies are used to understand and analyze the key performance indexes of the website which helps in delivering a better user experience for the visitors.
